

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1. Components and dimensions

H201-LG includes the following components:

- Chamber Frame and Sample Holder.
- Glass lid
- Total weight on Galvo Stage: about 100 g with standard sample holder; about 20 g with MW plate holder. For details, see the table at page 4.

Configuration 1. H201-LG with standard sample holder




Figure 1. H201-LG - Configuration1. Components and Dimensions

Note: The sample holder acts as chamber base and it changes completely according to the needs of the end user.

Configuration2. H201-LG with MW Plates




Figure 2. H201-LG - Configuration2. Components and Dimensions

Note: In this configuration the Lid and the Frame may be screwed on the fixed part of the piezo stage.

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


Figure 3. Available sample holders.

3. Insertion of the Sample Feedback Temperature Sensor

Insert the Sample Feedback Temperature Sensor through the dedicated opening on the short side of the chamber (see Figure 4). Alternatively use one of the 12 perfusion holes located in the H201-LG frame (see Figure 4, Front and 3D views). Small screws plug the perfusion holes when not in use. (Grub screws M3x6). Remove small screw as needed before introducing the sample Feedback Temperature Sensor.

4. Assembly of the sample holders with chamber frame




Figure 5. Introduction of the Specimen Holder inside the Chamber Base.

The standard sample holder and chamber frame are assembled with 2 screws (Captive Screws) as shown in Figure 5.

5. Working with 35 or 60 mm Petri Dish




Figure 6. Plate adapter for 35mm Petri-dish holder.




Figure 7. Plate adapter for 60 mm Petri-dish holder.

Flat springs prevent movement of 35 and 60 mm dishes inside of the sample holder (See Figure 6 and Figure 7).




Figure 8. 1) Insertion of the ring, 2) insertion of the 35 mm dish, 3) springs closure





Figure 9. 1) Insertion of the ring, 2) insertion of the 60 mm dish, 3) springs closure

Spacing rings accounting for variability in dish diameter from one manufacturer to another are also included. The provided spacing rings can be used to center the 35 and 60 mm dishes inside the circular opening. Figure 8 and Figure 9 show how to position the ring. Ring selection guide diagrams: rings for 35 and 60 mm dish -Figure 10 and Figure 11, respectively.

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6. Working with 1x3" and 1x2" chamber slides

Flat springs prevent movement of 1"x 3" and 1"x 2" chamber slides inside of the sample holder.




Figure 12. Plate adapter for Lab-Tek 1"x2" chambered cover glass holder.




Figure 13. Plate adapter for Lab-Tek II 1"x2" chambered cover glass holder

Note: slight differences in size exist between Lab-Tek and Lab-Tek II plate adapters. Please specify the one needed at the time of purchase.

7. Working with MW Plates




Figure 14. Multiwell Plate insertion

For the Users that work with the MW Plates, H201-LG is equipped with a specific MW plate holder. To see how to use the MW holder see Figure 14. A small rubber spacer prevents MW Plates from moving inside of the multiwell plates holder. See Figure 14, Image 1 and Image 2.

Note: The Lid and Frame of the H201-LG for MW Plates are different from the Lid and Frame of the H201-LG for standard sample holders

8. Connecting the Gas Supply

A single silicon tubing carries output gas from the Okolab Gas Controller to the H201-LG. Silicon tubing connects to a gas input - brass opening - located on a corner of the H201-LG-BL. See Figure 15. Connect by gently pushing silicon tubing onto brass opening.

9. Working with Perfusion

The H201-LG features 12 perfusion holes for the insertion of perfusion tubing up to 2.5 mm in outer diameter. Small screws plug the perfusion holes when not in use. (Grub screws M3x6). Remove small screws as needed before introducing perfusion tubing.

Figure 16 shows the location of perfusion holes.

10. Installing the Chamber on the Galvo stage




Figure 17. How to install the H201-LG on the Galvo stage-with sample holder

When using H201-LG with sample holders, it fastens on the Galvo stage as shown in Figure 17; place the chamber on the stage and tighten the four captive screws (See Figure 17, Image 1 and Image 2).




Figure 18. How to install the H201-LG on the Galvo stage-with MW plate

When using H201-LG with MW plates, install it on the Galvo stage as shown in Figure 18:

- 1. Place the MW plate holder on the stage and tighten the four captive screws (See Figure 18, Image 1 and Image 2)
- 2. Place the chamber frame on the stage and tighten the two screws M2.5x3 (See Figure 18, Image 3 and Image 4)
- 3. Place the lid on the chamber as shown in Figure 18, Image 5
- 4. Figure 18, Image 6 shows H201-LG with MW plate holder on the Galvo stage
